Helpful information when taking a taxi to and from the Airport: 24/7 metered taxi service is available outside the "Makedonia" Airport Terminal building.

THE VAFOPOULIO CULTURAL CENTER

(Address: G. Vafopoulos 3, ~ 30 minutes from the airport by car)

The Poet and Academician George T. Vafopoulos and his wife Anastasia, in the spirit of the Ancient Greece as well as the National Benefactors and expressing their deep love

for Thessaloniki, offered their entire property to the Municipality of Thessaloniki in 1979. People with inspiration and vision wanted to give to our City a Cultural Center where Literature, Art, Theater and Music could find a place of expression.

The Vafopoulio Cultural Center was inaugurated in 1983, and its activities cover thirty five years of presence in the cultural affairs of the city. The Center is directed by the Municipality Committee, an Executive Committee and a Director.


It is a complex of two six-storey buildings with an overall area of 4.000 sq. m. arranged in such a way that all kinds of cultural artistic and fine arts functions can easily be staged.

The hubs of activity of the Vafopoulio are its three libraries, the multi-functional hall on the 4th floor, the exhibition rooms on the 5th floor, the theatre hall and a lecture hall on the 6th floor.
